A section of the whole site is provided to show the spacial relationship between the building and surrounding.







With the help of Google Maps and Google Earth a 3d view of the area is


provided.

A section toward the north side shows the structure of the shelf and the organisation of different levels of the factory

It also shows how the stair box is located next to the void and the rest of the building surrounded these two.

The main entrance of the factory is at the east side of the building, It opens to the delivery hall right next to the fermentation tanks.

## Ground floor

Located at the east side of the building is the factory yard with a parking area for employees and a covered parking area for machines. there is the entrance for the factories collection and delivery hall. Directly next to the entrance are two storages located.

The elevator door is right in front in order to transport the grapes to the pressing machines, bottles to filling hall or boxes to the transportation hall. There is also a stairbox for employees to access all other levels.

From the factory yard there is also the door to the kitchen of restaurant as well as the stair box which goes to level -2 .

At the north side of the building, next to the visitors parking area, the main entrance is located. It is opened to the wine store and lobby.

Next to the reception is the heart of the bulding located, the visitor stair box which is covered with curtain walls in order to give the best view possible to the factory and also provides them with a view to the river while walking down the stairs.

Five hotel rooms are also in this level along the hallway which is also the access to the terrace and restaurant.

The main entrance of the building is north oriented and is directly at the street to have an easy and fast access for pedestrians .

This view was initially important to give a view to the production for visitors without entering the area.
This room is isolated and having these windows it became like a show room.

The outside stairs locating on the south side of the bulding are providing both a connection between floors and a plaform with the shape of stairs instead of just a terrace to enjoy the outside einvironment. Visitors can grab a glass of wine and sit on these stairs and enjoy the good weather, Stairs are located under a roof in order to provide a shelter agains rain and sun.

## Level -1

Using the advantages of topography this level is partly underground and partly on the ground.

on the east side of the plan is the aging tanks level on the factory shelf and next to it is the technical room and the laboratory.

Also the barrel storage is located in this level as a isolated box, facing the factory from one side and facing the restaurant from the other side.

At south side of the plan restaurant and bar is located which is on the ground and has access to the landscape and river side.

Visitors have access to this level by the elevator and the stair box. There are 5 other hotel rooms located at this level plus 2 suites which are designed with barrier free bathrooms.



The visitor stair box is the heart of the building. It works not only as a vertical connection through levels but also as a walking gallery of wine production.

It is covered by curtain walls to give a full view from top to down. Also people accomodating in the hotel, the moment that they are out of their room they see the factory behind the glasses and that is how the sleep over in winery becomes real.

The void provided next to the stairs is also giving a great view to the whole stair case, which is a sculptural element, from every level.

## Level -2

Bottle cleaning and bottle filling machines will be located at this level right under the factory shelfs in order to use the gravity to bring the wine from tanks and barrels to bottles. next to this area is the storage for bottles and boxes. There is a direct acces from storage to the elevator in order to transport the boxes and bottles.

Accessibility to this area is by the main staircase and elevator and also the second stair case which is connected to outside.


This level is also the last level of the visitor stair box, which gives them a great view through the curtain wall. It is also accessible with the visitor elevator. The communication between stair box and the factory at this level is limited and oriented carefully due to the isolation of the bottle filling area.

Second public bathroom for men and women is placed at this level to give service to both visitors and Employees.
















Level -2 M. 1:200

Level 1 at the east side of the plan is the higher level of the factory shelf located. this is the area for grape pressing machines which is accessable by the factory elevator and stair case.

An area is located on top of the lobbey An area is located on top of the lobbey and hotel rooms to provide the offices and changing rooms. It has access for employees through the factory stair case and elevator and is also connected to the lobby by the visitor elevator.


there is a great view to the factory and the visitor stair box from this level which is an advantage for the management team to be able to observe the whole atmosphere.
